2018-19 Budget Highlights

Through Their Futures Matter, children and young people will benefit from support that helps their parents change so that safety, wellbeing, health and education improve. Where parents cannot change, children need to have a forever home through open adoption or guardianship.

OVER TWO YEARS FOR THE ADOPTION TRANSFORMATION PROGRAM to increase

the number of adoptions from Out-of-Home Care.



\$639 million

IN 2018-19 FOR PERMANENCY SUPPORT PROGRAM PROVIDERS to enable children and young people to fulfil their case plan goal for permanency within 2 years and tailor responses to suit their individual needs.

\$6.5 million

FOR 52 FACS PERMANENCY COORDINATORS to support caseworkers to achieve permanency goals.
