2018-19 Budget Highlights

\$4 million FOR WOMEN NSW TO ADVANCE GENDER EQUITY AND IMPROVE ECONOMIC OPPORTUNITIES FOR WOMEN AND GIRLS THROUGH WOMEN'S POLICY.

\$400,000 FOR THE INVESTING IN WOMEN GRANTS to promote gender equity in the workplace and financial security for women.



SUPPORT FOR THE COUNCIL ON WOMEN'S ECONOMIC OPPORTUNITY which provides advice to the government on policies and programs.

ENTERPRISING YOUNG WOMEN

which delivers entrepreneurship workshops for young women of cultural and linguistically diverse backgrounds.



WOMEN IN CIVIL

which encourages and supports women joining and remaining in the civil construction industry, with a particular focus on regional NSW.



THE W PROJECT

which delivers leadership skills and economic empowerment to women in small business, women in leadership roles and young women.



CAREER WOMEN'S MENTORING PROGRAM

which aims to build leadership capacity, career planning and confidence in regional women.



THE ECONOMIC EMPOWERMENT & LEADERSHIP OF NSW WOMEN IN MALE-DOMINATED TRADES

which supports women seeking career opportunities in the building and construction industry.



THE STEP STONE PROJECT

which provides accessible high-quality training in Computer Literacy and Communication Skills to women who face barriers (lack of funds, family commitments, or just being unaware of available opportunities) to gaining employability skills.
