# \$3.2 billion

ON NSW GOVERNMENT INVESTMENT IN THE NATIONAL DISABILITY INSURANCE SCHEME (NDIS).



**\$2.7 BILLION**  
CASH CONTRIBUTION FOR SUPPORTING PEOPLE WITH DISABILITY IN THE NDIS, taking the NSW Government contribution to \$3.2 billion in total.



**\$477.5 MILLION**  
IN-KIND CONTRIBUTIONS THROUGH SERVICES PROVIDED BY NSW GOVERNMENT AGENCIES.

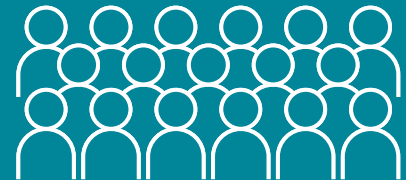


### Key programs include:

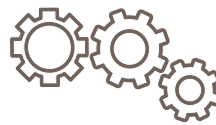
